

HOME OFFICE and VEHICLE EXPENSE DEDUCTIONS WORKSHEET

Note: The IRS is very particular about property tax deductions. Because of this, for real estate and vehicle taxes, please only include the <u>actual tax portion</u> of the amount paid to the government entity. Be sure to <u>include</u> any state, local, or foreign taxes on real property, charged uniformly against all property in the jurisdiction, based on the assessed value. <u>Exclude</u> local benefit taxes for improvement, such as assessments for streets, sidewalks and sewer lines. These can be added to the cost basis of your property to be used against capital gains.

You can either deduct recorded business-use mileage —OR- actual expenses (gas, oil changes, car washes, tune ups, etc.) and vehicle depreciation. If you have a vehicle that is both personal and business, you must provide both the total as well as actual business mileage reported (even if you are writing off actual amounts for auto expense).
